★ School Trustee Report - Melyssa absent -

Ian 23 meeting

- The Mechanics Training Program celebrates its 25th anniversary. Partnership with Cam Clark Ford in Airdrie. Allows high school kids to work and learn in mechanics trade through hands-on instruction. Mr. Teasdale and 2 past students shared about the program.
- Board made a decision on how to better balance Chestermeres's Schools. 262% rise in population growth over 2 decades RVS' schools in Chestermere were experiencing significant and sustained growth.
- Changes will be shared with impacted families and school communities. Notable changes Chestermere will now have a middle school!
- Muriel Clayton Middle school designation adjusted to address utilization.
- The Board of Trustees made decisions for school designations for students in Prairie Springs to help higher projected utilization at Mureil Clayton.
- Beginning 2025\2026 school year students in prairie springs will attend: K-9 @ Windsong Heights and 10-12 @ Croxford. More information is available on the website. Communication of changes were sent out shortly after the final decision was made to help prepare for the upcoming year.
- Provincial Gov't mandatory literacy and numeracy screening and assessment results were shared. Based on results RVS is targeting gov't provided disruption funding to provide additional support for 10 schools. Other schools may reach out and each request will be considered
- RVS administered a new numeracy assessment aligned with the curriculum for grade 4-10 students
- Survey about AERR will go out again for 2025 with intention to expand the survey to parents. For grades 4-12
- RVS is expanding and deepening positive behaviour interventions and supports PBIS implementation across all schools and on school buses.
- Trustee Orientation AD HOC Committee created for upcoming trustee election. The committee will help to guide development and delivery of the orientation process for new trustees.
- Board received a letter from Minister of Education, Demetrios Nicolaides.Board will
 continue to advocate for change to the current weighted Moving Average funding
 model to one which provides funding for every student each year.
- School Council Survey CLOSED on Feb 10 2025.
